Clinic Connects Volunteer and Patient in Need of New Leg

Guadalupe Clinic is blessed with a wide range of volunteer specialists. No matter how niche their specialty may seem, we always have patients in need of their help. Joe Raub began volunteering at the Clinic early last year. An ABC certified prosthetist and orthotic fitter, Joe works at the VA and volunteers at Guadalupe to help those in need of prosthetics and orthotics. A time-consuming and expensive process, Joe works with each patient to cast molds and fit them, which takes several appointments, depending on their individual needs. We are grateful to have him and the lifechanging work he does.



Andy has been a patient at Guadalupe since November 2023. He lost his left leg in a terrible car accident in Mexico in 2015. Since then, he has depended on the aid of crutches and a wheelchair. Andy has faced many

hardships since immigrating to the United States. He lost his wife this year, and was just recently offered a new position that he was forced to refuse, due to his lack of mobility.

Fortunately, the Clinic was able to connect Joe and Andy, and Joe fit Andy with a new prosthetic leg in April of this year. We've also scheduled Andy for physical therapy sessions, which are crucial in helping him learn to walk with his new limb, which was generously donated by Limbs for Life. Andy sees a bright future

ahead, and we couldn't be happier for him!
